Accredited with Quality by the Georgia Accrediting Commission, Heritage Classical Study Center is an **independent and private Christian study center**, providing a classical and Christian supplement to home educators at the middle and high school levels. Heritage is a unique learning experience designed to support homeschooling families by molding students into thinkers - young men and women who do not simply regurgitate the information they have been fed but rather who analyze, critique, and affect the world by applying Biblical wisdom to their lives, families, and communities. Our students attend in-person classes one day a week, where they engage in rigorous, discussion-based lessons led by experienced instructors. The rest of the week, they continue their studies at home, guided by a carefully structured curriculum.

Our program emphasizes a classical education model, which means we focus on core humanities subjects—**History, Literature, Composition, Logic, and Classical Languages**. For 6th grade only during 2025-2026, we will also provide **Math and Science** classes.

At Heritage, we seek not just knowledge, but understanding and wisdom as well. Knowledge is "knowing the answer." Understanding is knowing why it's the answer. Wisdom is applying the understanding of truth to one's life in a godly fashion. It is our goal that Heritage students learn to THINK, Biblically and logically. The Heritage student is taught to be a lifelong learner of new information, to consistently evaluate and critique relevant issues, and to always seek skillfully to communicate his thoughts. We desire for all students at Heritage to learn factual and philosophical truth, learn to evaluate the messages they are receiving from the world around them, and learn to defend their beliefs in a persuasive and winsome manner.

Admissions

- Applications may be completed on our website or downloaded and returned via email or delivered by hand. www.heritageclassical.com
- An integral part of the application is a handwritten essay by the student explaining how Heritage can aid in their future goals. There is space provided to do this within the online application, but an essay attached to the application or emailed to juliawright.heritage@gmail.com is also sufficient.
- Application Fee: **\$75** (\$150 if after May 1st) nonrefundable application fee per student which is to be submitted with the application.
- Students are accepted on a first come, first served basis.

An application is not complete without either the essay or application fee.

Next Steps:

Upon acceptance you will receive:

1. A Contract - Outlining our responsibilities and yours as a family.
 - a. The signed contract must be returned with a registration fee of \$250 per student regardless of when the application was made.
2. A handbook with more information regarding our Offsite Credit Transfer program.
3. General information about Heritage including details about uniforms and other resources.
4. A list of books and supplies for the school year (including book ISBN and edition).

Tuition:

- **HIGH SCHOOL students** enrolling for the 2025-2026 academic year, the annual tuition is \$3015 (\$335 per month). After the enrollment of the first child in a family, yearly tuition for any additional students in the same family is discounted. The oldest student is always full price.
- **6th/7th/8th grade students**, the annual tuition is \$2880 (\$320 per month). After the enrollment of the first child in a family, yearly tuition for any additional students in the same family is discounted. The oldest student is always full price.

Families may pay for the school year's tuition in one payment at the beginning of the school year, in two payments (one in August, one in January), or in nine monthly payments.

6 / 7 / 8	\$320	\$285

(The oldest student is always considered the first student.)

- Example 1: One High School Student and one 6-8th Student = \$620
- Example 2: Two High School Students = \$635
- Example #3 Two 6-8th Students = \$605
